


## Plan

<b>Proficiency Level</b>	Novice Mid
<b>Title</b>	<a href="#"><u>Árboles</u></a>
<b>Summary</b>	Students raise awareness of what trees teach us by sharing a recording with the community of their dramatization of the book <a href="#"><u>Árboles</u></a> and by creating a 'quilt' poster indicating how they are planning to help protect trees
<b>What are my learning targets?</b>	<p><b>I can...</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Describe the cover of the book <a href="#"><u>Árboles</u></a> using the PZ Thinking Routine: I see - I think - I wonder</li> <li>● Explain what it says on the pages in the book by creating motions according to what I listen</li> <li>● Recite and perform a sentence from the book to share with the community</li> <li>● Connect the book to the SDGs related to Planet</li> <li>● Explain through drawing what I am planning to do to help protect trees</li> </ul>
<b>What is my essential understanding?</b>	<i>What can we learn from trees?</i>

<p><b>What is the input /resource?</b></p>	 <p><u>Árboles</u></p>
<p><b>How do we build background knowledge?</b> <b>How do we activate prior knowledge?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review the Sustainable Development Goals by organizing them into the 5 following categories: People - Planet - Peace - Partnerships - Prosperity</li> <li>• Students match pictures to words according to keywords in the book</li> </ul>
<p><b>What is my introduction to this lesson?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Describe the cover of the book using the PZ Thinking Routine: Veo - Pienso - Me pregunto</li> </ul>
<p><b>How do I want my students to process this input?</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students listen to the story and come up with a motion for each page</li> <li>• Students listen to the story again and make the corresponding motions</li> <li>• After reading the book <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students read sentence-strips with sentences from the book</li> <li>○ Students dramatize the sentences and choose one to perform</li> <li>○ Students use Flipgrid to record themselves dramatizing sentences from the book. Teacher shares the recording with the community to bring awareness of what we can learn from trees</li> </ul> </li> </ul>


	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students connect the book to the SDGs that correspond to Planet</li> </ul>
<b>How could we reflect upon your learning?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students reflect on how they can help protect trees           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students create a 'quilt' poster out of the class drawings indicating ways in which they are planning to help protect trees</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>What extension activities could be done?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students watch the video on the book <a href="#"><i>Arboles</i></a> and compare it to the book. They explain what they like of each</li> <li>● Students prepare a collage with photos of their favorite tree in their neighborhood</li> <li>● Invite a guest speaker to talk about trees</li> </ul>


### EdTech Ideas
